The 2 offerings include 4 years of Extended Life Cycle Support (ELC) with access to Red Hat Enterprise Linux 7 security patches and updates until June 2028.

Red Hat Enterprise Linux for Third Party Linux Migration offerings will be available for on-site datacenter deployments and on Amazon Web Services (AWS), Microsoft Azure, and Google Cloud via cloud provider marketplaces and Red Hat Cloud Access.
